Teddy Bear Pattern

Task: To make two identical teddy bears for babies that pass away. Families are able to keep one with the baby and keep an identical one in the keepsake box we provide.

Material: Please use baby soft wool or yarn.

Suitable colours: White, cream, lavender, pastel pink, pastel green or pastel blue. Please do not use yellow, the colour is not suitable due to some babies being very jaundiced.

Sizes: Any of the following sizes can be used as long as they are a matching set of two.

Small Teddy Bear

3ply 2.5 mm (14)

4ply 2.00 mm (12)

Medium Teddy Bear

4 ply 2.5mm (12)

Large Teddy Bear

Take 2sts less on each leg and arm

5ply 3.25mm (10)

Instructions

Cast on 10 stitches and knit 20 rows-leave on needle.

Cast on 10 stitches and knit 20 rows. These sections form the legs (front)

Knit 26 rows across 2 legs. These rows form the body (front)

Cast on 12 stitches in next 2 rows and knit 10 rows. These rows form the arms (front)

Cast off 12 stitches at the beginning of the next 2 rows and then knit 46 rows. These rows form the front and back of head.

Cast on 12 stitches in the next 2 rows, knit 10 rows. These rows form the arms (back)

Cast off 12 stitches at the beginning of the next 2 rows and knit 26 rows. (These rows form the body (back).

on the next row knit across 10 stitches and continue knitting these stitches for 20 rows. Cast off
Join yarn to the remaining 10 stitches and knit 20 rows. Cast off. These last 2 sections form the legs (back)

Sew the front and back of the bear together and stuff firmly.

Sew across corner of head to form ears.

Embroider a neutral expression on face with fine stranded cotton or crochet cotton (not wool).

Tie a bow around the bear's neck.
