Role and Responsibilities:	 Able to commit to a scheduled roster for a minimum period of 12 months Knowledge of organisation's programs, operations and services Welcome all families and provide a safe and nurturing environment for parents and children Set up/pack down NurtureGroup activities and toys Arrange and prepare morning tea Arrange appropriate Allied Health Professionals to attend groups Always remain professional and supportive Inform parents of your role and boundaries - in which you cannot offer medical advice but that you are solely there to provide parent support Provide information about ongoing support available from Miracle Babies Foundation or external services current in Australia Ensure sensitive and private information is secure at all times
